Boys Hope Girls Hope Is Changing Lives!

Boys Hope Girls Hope of Arizona (BHGH) helps academically capable youth-in-need by providing academic support, enrichment opportunities, and the resources scholars need to reach their full potential. At BHGH, 95% of our scholars come from low-income families and will be the first in their family to graduate college. From the start of sixth grade through college graduation, scholars gain access to the resources and support necessary to obtain a college degree, become true leaders in their communities, and break the generational cycle of poverty for themselves and their families.

What is the BHGH difference?

- The Residential Program serves 8 boys and 8 girls. The Academy Program serves up to 42 scholars. There are currently 36 young adults in the College Program. At BHGH, 95% of BHGH scholars are low-income, first generation college students.
- Today's four-year college graduates will earn nearly \$1 million more over their working lives than will those who only receive a high school diploma. At BHGH, 70% of our scholars graduate from college within six years, compared to 11% of like students.
- BHGH Collegians have a diverse list of majors, some have dual majors and a few finishing their bachelor's degree in less than 4 years. At BHGH, 75% of college graduates are working in their field of study. Their professions include Naval Officer, TV news writer, Civil Engineering, Surgical ICU Nurse, Attorney, Landscape architect, Financial Management and more.
- Program graduates are attending or have attended Arizona State University, Smith College, Colgate, Colorado College, Dartmouth College, DePaul University, Gonzaga, Northern Arizona University, Pepperdine, St. Anselm College, St. Louis University, St. Edwards, University of Arizona, the University of Southern California, Yale University and more. Of our 36 enrolled BHGH collegian, 81% have no student debt. Those who do have debt, it is less than \$8,000, compared to the national level of \$30,000 in 2020.
