Thanks to an investment by the Virginia G. Piper Charitable Trust, BHGH has embarked on a Cultural Fluency initiative. This is not a project; but a permanent shift in the way BHGH empowers our scholars and families to shape their futures. More than 90% of BHGH scholars are ethnic-minorities, are from low-income families and are first generation college goers. 

GIVING BACK








